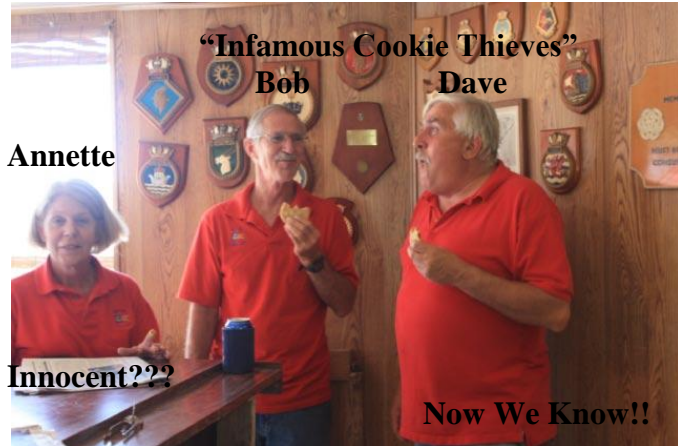
## *From the Vice*

1 – Term for stretch of public stream where fish caught must be released alive.

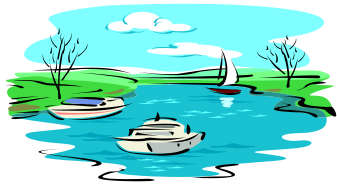

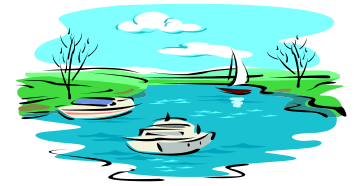
